The Kansas Department of Agriculture/Division of Water Resources/Floodplain Management Team is pleased to announce upcoming FREE trainings that have been prepared especially with community officials in mind. These trainings provide Continuing Education Credits (CECs) for the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) program.

Basics of the National Flood Insurance Program

This free class is for officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinance. The focus is on the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. Approved 3.5 hours toward CFM. Class size is limited to 20 participants on a first come first serve basis. **When/Where:**

Elevation Certificates and Letters Of Map Amendment

This free class is designed for community officials responsible for administering floodplain management as well as surveyors and engineers who complete Letters Of Map Amendment (LOMA) and Elevation Certificate forms. The course will focus on accurate completion of Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) technical forms, building diagrams and base flood elevation. Approved 3.5 hours toward CFM. Class size is limited to 20 participants. **When/Where:**

8:30am - 12:30pm, Oct. 1, 2014, Chapman

Post Flood Responsibilities

This free class is intended for community officials responsible for administering floodplain management regulations. The course focuses on what to do during and after a disaster event. Topics include substantial damage, permitting, Increased Cost of Compliance and violations. Approved 3.5 hours toward CFM. Class size is limited to 20 participants. **When/Where:**
