



Prior to these current positions Mr. Behm has served as a Program Manager, a Hydraulic Design Engineer, and a Project Manager. He has been an employee of the Omaha District for 29 years.


Andy Megrail





September 5, 2013

- I. <u>Call to Order:</u> The meeting of the entire membership was called to order by Chairman Slone at 12:34 p.m. with the following officers present: Don Slone Chairman, Sam Seeley Vice-Chairman, Jon Bristor Treasurer, Mark Vonachen Secretary, Tonya Richards, At-Large Representative, and Tom Morey Kansas State NFIP Coordinator.
- II. <u>Approval of 2012 Annual Meeting Minutes:</u> Chairman Slone advised the membership the 2012 Annual meeting minutes are on pages 14-18 in the agenda booklet. Motion by Dan Garber to approve the 2011 annual meeting minutes as written; seconded by Kenny Cook. The motion was approved unanimously.
- **III.** <u>Treasurer's Report July 30, 2013:</u> Chairman Slone advised the membership the treasurer's report is found on pages 19-23 of the conference agenda booklet.

The association has incurred several new expenses as a result of becoming an official chapter under ASFPM. Some of those expenses are liability insurance, payments to the IRS for our non-profit status, and annual membership dues to ASFPM. This past year we also were able to change the website address to kafm.org instead of ekafm.org for a one time cost of \$800.

Motion by Tom Yahl to approve the treasurer's report as submitted; seconded by Steve Higgins. The motion was approved unanimously.

IV. <u>Election of Officers:</u> Chairman Slone announced the following people are seeking election to the Board of Directors:

Chairman Slone stated there are 114 people registered over the two days. Only 57 people submitted a ballot for the election. After the ballots were counted, Sam Seeley received 27 votes and Melissa Mitchell received 30 votes. Based on these results, Melissa Mitchell of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County is the new Vice-Chairman of KAFM for 2013-2014. The term for the Board of Directors is one year and runs from annual conference to annual conference.

Motion by Steve Samuelson to accept the results of the election; seconded by Linda Finger. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Chairman Slone stated in 2005 Kansas had 24 CFM's. In 2013 Kansas now has 118 CFM's. Slone congratulated all new CFM's on their achievement.

VIII. <u>Chairman's State of the Association</u>

Chairman Slone stated since this is the 10th annual conference he looked back and calculated the number of members from year to year. The association was established in Wichita in 1999 with 20 members. After a few years of inactivity, the association was revived in 2004. The number of members at each annual conference was as follows:

Chairman Slone said his goal has never been to increase the membership numbers. His goal is to provide a service so when you leave the conference you have learned something new about floodplain management to help assist your community or business. The growth of the organization has been good and steady. The Board has implemented a stormwater management section to the conference. The Board has taken the position that a person cannot separate stormwater management from floodplain management. There are currently 27 PE's at this conference. Of those 27 PE's, 22 of them are also a CFM.

Chairman Slone announced there are 25 new members or first time attendees to the conference.

Slone thanked Treasurer Bristor for all his work on completing the IRS paperwork. The IRS determined the organization is a 501.C6 Non-Profit Organization. Each year the organization will file a tax return to the IRS using form N-990 which shows we are a tax exempt organization.

Chairman Slone said Liability Insurance for the Board has increased to \$650 while ASFPM Chapter dues will increase to \$300 in 2014, \$400 in 2015, and \$500 in 2016.

The Board has authorized Tom Morey to apply to ASFPM to co-host a FEMA 4-day NFIP 273 course in Kansas. ASFPM requires state and chapter support. If selected to host this course, it will be held in Wichita for the first 35 people who register. No date has been selected but it could be between October 1, 2013 and December 31, 2013. As of today the Board has not received word if Kansas was selected. KAFM will assist in paying for some of the lunches or other expenses associated with hosting this training course.

IX. Other Business

Chairman Slone stated he was in search of a Civil/Stormwater Engineer to sit on the Conference Training Committee and assist in determining future training classes related to stormwater management or floodplain management. John Covey of AMEC has accepted this position. Melissa Mitchell will also sit on the conference training committee.

The evaluations for the conference will be sent out to the membership approximately one-two weeks after the conference. Please respond to the evaluation so the Board of Directors can make this an even better conference next year. Last year only 51 of 108 evaluations were returned.

Conference certificates will be available at the registration desk after Session 8. Chairman Slone explained to those members that are CFM's to email or fax the certificate to Anita Larson at ASFPM right away. Do not hold on to the certificate until it is time to renew your certification as it may get lost. He has had to sign over five new certificates this last month because people have lost their certificate. The Board is not responsible for your certification and will no longer provide replacement certificates.



Please turn in your badge before you leave for re-use next year. There will be a box for the badges at the registration desk. This also helps to hold down association costs.

Next year's conference is September 3^{rd} and 4^{th} in downtown Wichita at the Hotel at Old Town. The planning committee will consist of Jon Bristor, Kelly Dixon, and Renee Batchman.

The 2015 Conference will be held on September 2nd and 3rd in Sumner County at the Kansas Star Hotel and Conference Center in Mulvane. The Planning Committee for this conference will consist of Jon Bristor, Barry Fleming, and Ray Fleming.

The Board is looking for volunteers to be on the Planning Committee and host the 2016 Conference.

Chairman Slone recognized Kenny Cook for obtaining AICP and Erica Stanley of DWR who was recently elected as the ASFPM Region VII Director.

Tom Morey reminded everyone there are three classes for Session 8 not two as shown in the conference brochure.

X. Adjourn

There being no other items brought before the Board, **Steve Higgins moved to adjourn; seconded by Gina Bell. The motion passed unanimously.** The meeting adjourned at 1:04 p.m.
